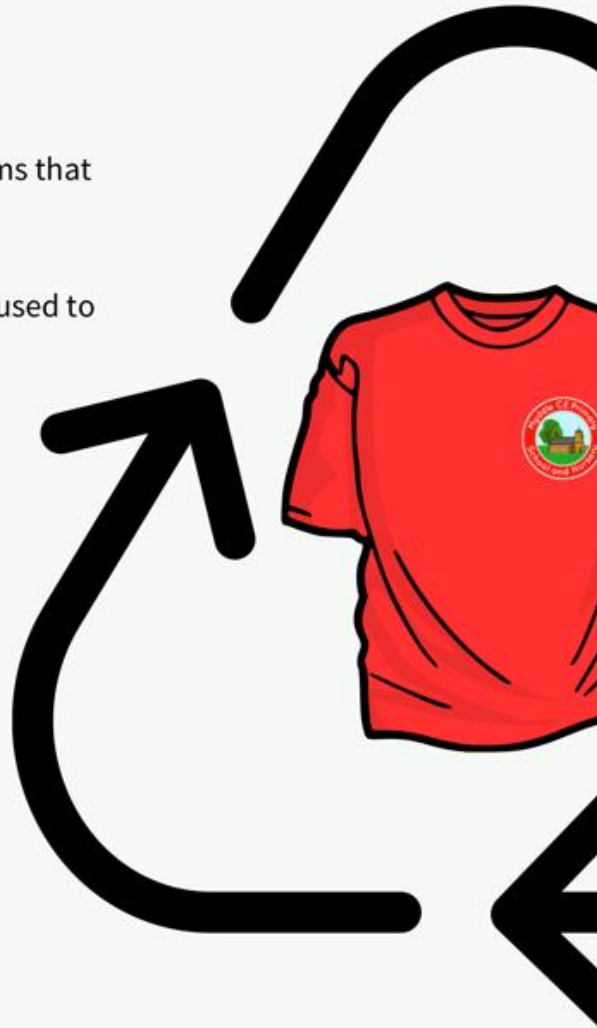
We accept any pre-loved items that are in good condition.
