### Highlights of the week

#### Snow Leopards

This week, Nursery have been learning about the Polar Regions and have enjoyed playing with snow (gloop – made from flour and water) and real ice!

#### Panda Class

Panda class have also been learning about the Polar Regions. They learnt about the differences between the Arctic and Antarctic and the different animals that live there.

#### Tiger Class

The children in Tiger class have been very busy writing diary entries. They watched a short animation about a Meer Kat to link in with their class book 'Meer Kat Mail' and then wrote a diary entry from that character's perspective.

#### Rhino Class

Rhino Class have been learning maths in a very different way this week. On Thursday, they took to the school field to complete a number of challenges in pairs and small groups. They learnt about fractions, weight and measurement and had to use a range of calculations methods to solve problems.
